Safe and Appropriate Behavior at Voyagers

All adults and children of member families must read, sign, and abide by Voyagers Code of Conduct and Outdoor Use Policy, and be mindful of other safety reminders, with the understanding that the Voyagers Board reserves the right to review membership privileges when necessary.

These rules are subject to change with posted notice.

Voyagers Homeschool Cooperative Code of Conduct

The Voyagers Homeschool Cooperative is for homeschooling families to use for activities both educational and social. While we aim to provide space for children to use, it is not a day care facility, so children must be accompanied by a parent or designated responsible adult. This designation must be made by the parent or legal guardian in writing and will be kept as part of our permanent records. Children may be left with a responsible adult by using the sign-out sheet at the front desk. There must be at least two adults present on site at all times (unless a single adult is the responsible adult for all children present). All adults and children of member families must read and sign the "Code of Conduct" form. In the event of a violation of the Code, the Voyagers Board of Directors reserves the right to review membership privileges and take appropriate action when necessary.

Rules of Conduct

1. Members, adults and children, will treat each other and any instructors with consideration and respect.
2. Parents agree to monitor and guide their children to behave in a way that is considerate of other members, their property, and the property of the Voyagers group.
3. Under no circumstances may any member intentionally harm another.
4. There is to be no running in the building.
5. Please leave all weapons, real or pretend, at home.
6. Groups and individuals who use space at Voyagers are responsible for leaving the rooms clean and in a useable condition.
7. Parents must sign their children in and out, and be sure there are valid "Transfer of Oversight" forms in effect before leaving any children at the building.
8. Families agree to read and follow Voyagers Outdoor Use Policy.
9. Families may visit once at no charge, and may try classes once at no charge, with prior permission from the Directors.
10. Parents are expected to perform coop assignments to help the center run smoothly. The Coop Job Coordinator will assign jobs as needed.

Voyagers Outdoor Use Policy

Voyagers building at 530 Main Street, Acton, MA, has lovely outdoor space. Using it wisely and responsibly will help us preserve our privileges.

1. Stay within the "designated use" area. Study groups may occasionally go beyond these bounds for specific purposes.
2. No playing in parking lots and roads unless the area has been roped off for that purpose.
3. In general, children under 18 must be supervised outdoors by an adult. However, a child 12 or over, when accompanied by at least one other person 12 or over, may be outside in the designated-use areas without adult supervision.
4. Carry In/Carry Out policy — if you bring anything to the outdoor area, please take it with you when you leave.
